Notice is hereby given that on Tuesday the 10th day of May, 2022 at the usual polling places in the election precincts of Fillmore County, Nebraska, an election will be held. The polls will open at 8:00 a.m. and close at 8:00 p.m. Said election will be for nominating candidates to various offices. Some races will not appear on the Primary Election ballot as the number of candidates filing does not exceed twice the number of vacancies; these candidates are declared nominated and advance to the November 8th General Election. Voters living in school districts that cross county lines will be voting on candidates and special issues in their respective districts.

School Bond Election
Heartland Community School, District #96

Proposition 1:

"Shall York County School District 0096 (Heartland Community Schools) in the State of Nebraska issue its bonds in a total principal amount not to exceed Five Million Six Hundred Ninety Thousand Dollars (\$5,690,000) for the purpose of financing the costs of (i) constructing additions to and renovations of the District's existing school building, including a new secure and accessible main entrance, new elementary classrooms, a new weight room and new locker rooms, improvements to the north gymnasium, and an enclosed connection to the ag and industrial shop building to the main school building, (ii) constructing, acquiring and installing related parking and other site improvements for such building and additions, and (iii) acquiring and installing necessary furniture and apparatus for such building and additions; said bonds to be issued from time to time, to be sold at such prices, to bear interest at such rates, to become due at such times, and to have such other terms and provisions, all as may be fixed and determined by the Board of Education of the District; and

"Shall the District cause to be levied and collected annually a special levy of taxes against all the taxable property in the District sufficient in rate and amount to pay the principal of, the premium, if any, and the interest on said bonds as the same become due?"

Proposition 2:

"Shall York County School District 0096 (Heartland Community Schools) in the State of Nebraska issue its bonds in a total principal amount not to exceed One Million Three Hundred Seventy Thousand Dollars (\$1,370,000) for the purposes of financing the costs of constructing, equipping and furnishing an addition, including related parking and site improvements, to the District's existing school building to provide space for pre-kindergarten and a community daycare; said bonds to be issued from time to time, to be sold at such prices, to bear interest at such rates, to become due at such times, and to have such other terms and provisions, all as may be fixed and determined by the Board of Education of the District; and

"Shall the District cause to be levied and collected annually a special levy of taxes against all the taxable property in the District sufficient in rate and amount to pay the principal of, the premium, if any, and the interest on said bonds as the same become due?"
